LOVE IN ACTION BROOKWOOD CHURCH MINISTRY PLAN



We display the reality of our faith by the way we love God and each other. Jesus confirmed this truth when He said, *"Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples."* John 13:35 (NLT)

A Note from Our Senior Pastor

DURING THIS PAST YEAR, BROOKWOOD HAS DEMONSTRATED LOVE IN ACTION BY EQUIPPING AND ENCOURAGING GOD'S PEOPLE TO:

CARE FOR THE HURTING. Over 4,160 hours of counseling were provided at no charge, 610 people were served by meal ministries, 94 families received financial assistance, and 577 peopled volunteered in care ministries.



SAVE THE LOST. 138 people participated in 8 mission trips, and 498 new churches were planted over the past five years in Liberia, Sierra Leone, and India by mission partners in places where there has never been a church.

GATHER FOR WORSHIP. The worship choir grew to 141 members, and giving increased by \$848,530 over the previous year (including \$284,538 given specifically to missions causes).

CONNECT THROUGH COMMUNITY. 1,936 people participated in Small Groups, 915 attended BrookwoodU, and 1,543 attended adult ministry events.

REACH THE NEXT GENERATION. We saw 286 salvations among children and students, and 255 teenagers participated in Small Groups.

THIS HAS BEEN A PERIOD OF GREAT ACCOMPLISHMENT THAT WE ACHIEVED TOGETHER THROUGH GOD'S GUIDANCE AND ENABLEMENT. OUR MINISTRY PLAN NEXT YEAR IS EVEN MORE CHALLENGING! HERE'S THE PLANNED SPENDING FOR EACH AREA OF OUR CHURCH'S MINISTRY FOR THE YEAR AHEAD:

THIS IS \$1.3 MILLION MORE THAN LAST YEAR'S BUDGET! One million dollars is devoted to our SET FREE Project in Andhra Pradesh, India, to feed, clothe, house, and teach the Good News of Jesus Christ to over 500 children who have been released from slavery. The remaining \$300,000 was given in 2011–2012 to support the Indian ministry effort (dollars were not included in last year's budget). Can we increase our giving by more than \$1 million this year? Yes, we can—if we are unified in purpose and all of us participate in praying, serving, and giving to achieve it.

- Provide opportunities for people to serve and care for others.

A STORY FROM A VILLAGE CHIEF IN SIERRA LEONE, WEST AFRICA

After seeing the *JESUS* film in his native language, the Muslim chief said, "I cannot rest. I was afraid to tell my wife because she was the leader of the Muslim women. But when I told her, I found out she was having the same experience with Jesus. I called the missionary and said, 'Please come tell us again what to do to become a Christian. Also, please show the *JESUS* film again, not only in the Susu language but also in Temne for our neighbor villages.'"





A STORY FROM AN 18-YEAR-OLD GIRL IN INDIA

"When I was 11, one of my sisters got sick and my father borrowed money to pay her bills. When he could not repay, I was taken as payment and became a slave in a rock quarry. I never expected that I would see the world again; I thought I would be in the quarry until I died. But Pastor Praveen came and freed me from the quarry. He and the church people treated me as if I was their own daughter. In the future, I want to be like Pastor Praveen and save other children from a life in the quarries. I want to help people. I thank God for making my new life possible. When I explain what my life is like now, I can only say that my life is like a princess."

- Provide operating expenses in cooperation with other churches and ministries of \$300,000 a year.


LOVE IN ACTION GATHER FOR WORSHIP \$1,631,715 Worship

HOW CAN YOU PUT LOVE IN ACTION?

It's easy to keep doing the same things in the same way without ever reaching for what's next. The most dangerous place to be in our faith is comfortable—that's where we stop pushing for what God wants to do through us next. Countless times in Scripture, Jesus challenged people to greater levels of commitment. In fact, in Matthew 16:24, Jesus said anyone who is a disciple of His will do three things: deny themselves, take up the cross, and follow Him. Every time Jesus offered that challenge, some stayed and some walked away.

The abundant life is found when we follow Christ into the unknown. Faith—real faith—is reckless. Brookwood Church seeks to empower people to recklessly leave behind what is comfortable and reach for what God is calling us to accomplish next.

Love is messy. But when we put love into action, it becomes a powerful force of change. You can become an agent of change by praying about what God is calling you to do next. God doesn't want to leave you where you are. He is calling you and your family to something greater.

CONSIDER TAKING THESE NEXT STEPS:

- 1. Become a member of Brookwood Church. Membership is about identifying with Brookwood and agreeing to partner together to create Kingdom impact in our community and around the world.
- 2. Find a place to volunteer. Service reminds us that people are the object of God's affection. When we help others in need, we become the hands and feet of Christ.


THE NEXT STEP

- Playing golf: \$50 per week, \$200 per month, \$2,600 per year.
- Manicure/pedicure: \$25 per month, \$300 per year.
- Movie tickets for a family of four: \$40 per week, \$160 per month, \$2,080 per year.
