Discussion Guide

Conversation Starter

Describe an opportunity you wish you would've taken but didn't.

Begin your study with prayer

Pause for a few minutes to quiet your heart and mind. Then ask God for insight and direction as you study and reflect on this week's lesson.

Introduction

This week's lesson focuses on a man who demonstrates what it looks like to have *A Chance Encounter* with Christ.

Bible Study and Group Discussion Read <u>Luke 19:1-10</u>.

- 1. What do you learn about Zacchaeus in these passages? Describe what life must have been like for him.
- 2. How did Zacchaeus express faith in Jesus?
- 3. Have you ever tried to get closer to Jesus but felt like something was in the way? If so, can you identify what that was?
- 4. What pain (need or challenge) in your life is God using to draw you closer to Him? How are you responding?
- 5. How did the people around Zacchaeus discourage his faith?
- 6. Consider those you're with most of the time. Do they help you see Jesus, or are they more of a distraction?

- 7. The Apostle Paul prayed for the church in Ephesus that the eyes of their heart would be enlightened [see Ephesians 1:18 (NIV)]. What's the difference between seeing with your eyes and seeing with your heart?
- 8. Was Zacchaeus changed after his encounter with Jesus?
- 9. What's one way you'd love God to work in your life?
- 10. What will you do to encounter Jesus this week?

Spiritual Practice

A spiritual practice is something we do to interrupt our usual thoughts, feelings and patterns, enabling us to move more deeply into the life of Christ.

Read <u>Luke 19:1-10</u> each day this week, and ask God what He wants you to know. Use this time to develop a life of persistent faith.
