# **Discussion Guide**

#### **Conversation Starter**

Describe a time you experienced either great joy or sorrow over the past few weeks.

### **Opening in Prayer**

Pause for a few minutes to quiet your heart and mind. Ask God to help you hear His voice during this week's study and reflection.

#### **Personal Reflection/Group Discussion**

#### Read <u>Revelation 3:14-22</u>.

- 1. Jesus is called *the Amen the faithful and true witness, the beginning of God's new creation* (vs. 14). What do these titles teach you about Jesus? What does He want you to know?
- 2. Laodicea's water supply was provided from a distant source through pipes. As a result, the water was lukewarm and barely drinkable. Jesus tells the church in Laodicea they are lukewarm (vs. 15-16). What does it mean for a person or a church to be lukewarm?
- 3. How does Jesus feel when a church becomes lukewarm (vs. 16)? Does this surprise you? Why or why not?
- 4. In what ways have you been lukewarm in your faith?
- 5. What are ways to overcome being lukewarm?
- 6. How did the Laodiceans see themselves? How did Jesus see them? Why is there such a radical difference between the two perspectives?

- 7. What motivates God to correct and discipline His children (vs. 19)? How does knowing you are His forever son or daughter help you receive His correction?
- 8. How will you think, feel or act differently as a result of what God has revealed to you in this week's teaching?

During this series we've asked God to write us a letter using the pattern in the letters to the churches in <u>Revelation 2-3</u>. Each week, we've added another section to the letter.
