Opening in Prayer

May you come to know God in new and beautiful ways this Christmas. Spend several minutes in silence. Ask God to guide your heart and mind as you study and reflect.

Personal Reflection/Group Discussion Read <u>Luke 1:39-56</u>.

- 1. Why do you think Mary hurried to see Elizabeth?
- 2. What do you think it must have been like for Mary and Elizabeth to share stories about their encounters with God?
- 3. Have you ever experienced God so powerfully you couldn't wait to share the story with someone? Who did you reach out to first?
- 4. How is Mary's faith an example to you?
- 5. Why do you think Luke included the detail that Elizabeth's baby jumped for joy in her womb when Mary arrived?
- 6. Mary seemed utterly convinced that God really is who He says He is. Have you ever been as confident as Mary about the character and faithfulness of God? Reflect on (or describe) that experience.

- 7. What specific characteristics of God does Mary's song highlight?
- 8. Have you ever seen or personally experienced God in any of the ways Mary described Him?
- 9. What sections of Mary's song resonate with your own heart and life right now? What thoughts come to mind as you read her song?

10. How do you sense God is calling you to respond to this week's teaching?
