Acts 21, 22

- 1. Paul knew, from the prophecy of Agabus, that imprisonment was impending if he continued to Jerusalem. So, how was he able to boldly move forward when most would shy away? (see Acts 21:10-14)
- 2. Have you ever had someone falsely accuse you of something? How did you feel?
- 3. Paul used this time of persecution to share the Good News. How can we share Jesus in the face of adversity?

LIVE IT

Paul was a great missionary who faced tremendous persecution and opposition. The message of the resurrected Jesus wasn't popular with many he met, yet he persevered. Likewise, our faith may not be popular today, but we endure for the sake of Jesus and His Kingdom.
