Conversation Starter

When you think of the story of Jesus' birth, what elements immediately come to mind?

Opening in Prayer

May God reveal Himself to you in a powerful way as you celebrate Christmas and approach the new year. Spend some time in silence. Ask God to guide your heart and mind as you study and reflect.

Personal Reflection/Group Discussion Read <u>Matthew 2:1-12</u>.

- 1. How do you think the wise men knew about the birth of Jesus from seeing a star in the sky?
- 2. Why was Herod so disturbed by what the wise men asked him?
- 3. When has God seemed the most real, the most tangible, the most *near* to you?
- 4. What are some of your favorite practices that help you grow in your relationship with God?
- 5. What are some reasons people don't believe in Jesus?
- 6. What could followers of Jesus do and say to help non-believers believe?

- 7. What are ways we can help each other grow in faith?
- 8. Have you ever sensed clear direction from God? If so, what did He say? How did you respond?
- 9. What happens when we don't take action when we sense God leading? See also: <u>1 Samuel 12:14-15</u>; <u>Hebrews 3:12-15</u>; <u>James 1:22-25</u>.

10. What's your biggest takeaway from this week's teaching?
