Introduction

While the message this Sunday is titled *Mothering through Crises* (in honor of Mother's Day), the principles have specific application for all of us as we seek to walk with God and follow His plan for our lives.

Opening in Prayer

Pause for a few minutes to quiet your heart and mind. Ask God to help you know Him more as you study and reflect on this week's lesson.

Conversation Starter

Who is, or was, one of your favorite teachers?

Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

Read Proverbs 22:6.

- 1. What did your parents do to protect you as you were growing up? (If you're a parent, what are you doing to protect your children?)
- 2. What do you wish your parents would have told you (or what did they tell you, but you didn't listen!)?

Read <u>Exodus 1:22-2:10</u>.

- 3. Summarize the main points of this story. Who are the main characters?
- 4. What other details about Moses' birth and upbringing are provided in <u>Acts 7:17-22</u> and <u>Hebrews 11:23-26</u>?
- 5. Moses, his sister, their parents, and the princess violated Pharaoh's clear and direct orders. What do you think appeared *special* about Moses that they'd be willing to put themselves in such great danger? How do you think they knew God's plan? See also: <u>Exodus 1:8-17</u>.

- 6. What are ways we're different from Moses? In what ways are we similar?
- 7. Can you think of a time when it seemed obvious what God wanted you to do? How did you know it was God?
- 8. How do you determine what God wants you to do when the situation and next steps aren't so clear?
- 9. To me, following God means _____
