Conversation Starter

What is your typical daily routine?

Begin your study with prayer

Pause for a few minutes to quiet your heart and mind. Ask God to help you experience His love and hear His voice as you reflect on this week's lesson.

Personal Reflection/Group Discussion Read Hebrews 11:32-35.

- 1. List some of the amazing things these men and women were able to do as they put their trust in God. How do their actions demonstrate faith?
- 2. When you think of people in the Bible who exercised great faith, who are the first people who come to mind? What is it about their lives that inspires you?
- 3. We each have a unique role in God's story. How is your life contributing to God's work?
- 4. What are ways you keep your eyes on God and trust in Him throughout the week? (see also: <u>Colossians 3:1-4</u>; <u>Hebrews 12:1-4</u>)
- 5. If God were writing the Bible today, do you think He would include you in the list of men and women of great faith? Why or why not?
- 6. What significant steps of faith have you taken over the last few years? How did you know God wanted you to take those steps?

- 7. In what areas of your life have you wanted to live with greater faith, but you've been met with challenges? How can you move beyond these obstacles?
- 8. What impact would you love to make in the world, in the church or in someone else's life this year?

Read Judges 13.

- 1. What did Samson do to become known as a man of great faith?
- 2. What were his failures?
- 3. What does the story of Samson teach you about living by faith?

Soul Training

Practice listening to God. Meditate on <u>Psalm 146</u>, focusing on specific words and phrases. What stands out to you? Ask God to fill your mind with His thoughts, and wait for Him to speak.
