Matthew 27:32–44

- 1. What stands out to you from these verses?
- 2. What feelings do you have when you read this passage?

LIVE IT

When you think about the cross, what comes to mind? You may experience a wave of emotions. Here are a few:

- 1. Happiness! Jesus died for us. How amazing is that?
- 2. Sadness. Jesus suffered and died by being crucified. The pain He experienced seems unimaginable.
- 3. Overwhelming Joy! Jesus knew the plan when He left His Father's side, and He chose to do it anyway. When it came time for Him to die, He could have walked away, but He loved us too much to stop. He understood that reuniting us with God and defeating sin was worth the sacrifice.
