- 5. Think of a time someone asked you to do something you knew was wrong. What did you do? Why? What were the results?
- 6. What impact has temptation had on your relationship with God?
- 7. How was Joseph able to remain faithful to God?

- 8. What practices help you remain strong in the face of temptation?
- 9. Can you think of a time someone you know gave in to temptation? What impact did that have on you? Describe.
- 10. What does this passage teach you about God?
- 11. What are ways you can follow Joseph's example?
