Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

Read <u>Exodus 33:11-14</u>.

- 1. What do you think it must have been like for Moses as he spoke face to face with God? For further insight, read Exodus 3:1-15; Numbers 12:6-8.
- 2. Have you ever experienced God intimately like that? Describe what it was like. How does knowing God change your perspective on life?
- 3. What do we learn about God from this passage?

Read Hebrews 11:1-6.

- 4. Complete this sentence in your own words: *Faith is*...
- 5. Besides God, who or what do many people put their faith in today?
- 6. Describe the examples of faith in these verses. Who was involved? What did they do? What was the result?
- 7. What does <u>Hebrews 11</u> teach us about living a God-centered life?

Read <u>James 2:14-17</u> and <u>1 John 4:7-8</u>.

- 8. How do these passages describe faith in action? How does your faith affect the way you live? Give specific examples.
- 9. What is the relationship between faith and experiencing God?
- 10. When you're going through a dry season, when God feels far away, what do you make of those times? How do those times affect how you think and feel about God?
- 11. What's one of the most important Bible verses or truths you learned from this week's teaching?
