## Discussion Guide

#### **Conversation Starter**

Describe a time you sensed God speaking to you.

#### Begin your study with prayer

Pause for a few minutes to quiet your heart and mind. Ask God to help you experience His love and hear His voice as you reflect on this week's lesson.

#### Bible Study and Group Discussion Read Jonah 3.

- 1. If you were Jonah, how would you have felt when the word of the Lord came to you a second time (<u>vs. 1-2</u>)?
- 2. How did Jonah respond to God's instruction? What did he do (vs. 3-4)?
- 3. What caused the people of Nineveh to believe God's message?
- 4. What's our role in helping people *welcome the Good News* of God as described in <u>Romans 10:13-17</u> and <u>2 Timothy 4:1-5</u>? What steps is God directing you to take?
- 5. What are several reasons people reject God?
- 6. What evidence is there the Ninevites were sincere in their repentance (vs. 5-9)? See also Matthew 12:38-42.
- 7. What would it take for a revival to happen in our city? What signs would you see if a revival were taking place?
- 8. Why did God change His mind (<u>vs. 10</u>)? Does that surprise you? Why or why not? What does <u>Ezekiel 18:23-32</u> teach you about God? See also <u>Jeremiah 18:7-10</u>; <u>Titus 3:4-6</u>.

### **Spiritual Practice**

Spiritual Practices help us experience the Holy Spirit's work in our lives. They're meant to be more than one-time actions, becoming a natural part of our lives.

Here's a simple process to help you draw closer to God. You might also use this as you help your children and friends hear God.

- 1. Find a quiet place and spend a few minutes in silence to clear your mind.
- 2. When you sense stillness, tell God you want to hear Him.
- 3. Slowly read and meditate on a passage of Scripture. What words or phrases stand out to you? (You can use the Memory Verse, Daily Readings or any passage.)
- 4. Ask God what He wants to say to you and allow time for Him to put thoughts in your mind.
- 5. God desires to talk with you all day long. So as you leave this quiet time with God, ask Him to speak to you throughout the day.
