# **Bible Study and Group Discussion**

### Read Acts 17:1-9.

- 1. Paul used the Scriptures to reason with the people (vs. 2). Which Bible passages do you usually refer to when talking with others about Jesus?
- 2. Which aspects of Jesus' life did Paul focus on?
- 3. What Old Testament passage best helps you understand our need for Jesus?

### Read Acts 17:10-15.

- 4. How would you describe the people of Berea?
- 5. Do you know anyone who's open-minded, maybe even eager, to have a conversation about Jesus? If so, who?
- 6. What do you imagine it would be like if they opened their heart to Jesus?

#### Read Acts 17:16-23.

- 7. What was the main concern Paul had with the people of Athens?
- 8. How did he reason with them?
- 9. What topic in the Bible do you wish you knew more about? Why is that topic important to you?
- 10. What does Acts 17 teach you about connecting with others?

## **Spiritual Practice**
