Conversation Starter

What's a miracle that happens every day?

Begin your study with prayer

Pause for a few minutes to quiet your heart and mind. Then ask God for insight and direction as you study and reflect on this week's lesson.

Bible Study and Group Discussion

Read <u>Acts 19:1-7</u>.

- 1. What's the difference between *the baptism of John* and being *baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus*?
- 2. How can you tell the Holy Spirit is at work in someone's life?
- 3. Describe a time you experienced the Holy Spirit.

Read <u>Acts 19:8-20</u>.

- 4. How was Paul's experience in Ephesus (<u>19:8-10</u>) similar to his experience in Corinth (<u>18:1-8</u>)?
- 5. Do you think all believers are given the power *to perform unusual miracles* like Paul? Why do you believe that?
- 6. How did the group of Jews who were casting out evil spirits misunderstand the power of God?
- 7. Why do you think the humiliation of those attempting to cast out evil spirits had such a wide-reaching effect (vs. <u>17-20</u>)?

- 8. Why does the Bible emphasize the power of Jesus' name?
- 9. As you read through this passage, what good fruit do you see from Paul's life and ministry?
- 10.Paul shows us what it looks like to be bold for Jesus. What's one way you could follow his example?
