#### Read <u>Luke 10:25-37</u>.

1. How would you describe the man who stood up to test Jesus?

- 2. Why did he ask Jesus who is my neighbor?
- 3. Compare and contrast the priest and temple assistant with the Samaritan. How did each of them respond to the man who was hurt?
- 4. To what extent did the Samaritan care for the man in need? Name specific ways he helped him.
- 5. Why did Jesus make a Samaritan the hero of this story?
- 6. Why did Jesus tell this story?
- 7. What attitudes and emotions surface when you encounter or relate to someone in need? What does this reveal about you?

- 8. Why is love so important to God?
- 9. Name some people you see regularly. How would their life be changed if you showed greater compassion? How would your life be changed by showing compassion?
- 10. What are some hurts or needs you have right now that you wished someone knew and cared about?

11. How is God leading you to respond to this week's lesson?
