Conversation Starter

What's something about you not many people know?

Begin your study with prayer

Pause for a few minutes to quiet your heart and mind. Ask God to help you experience His love and hear His voice as you reflect on this week's lesson.

Bible Study and Group Discussion

Read Colossians 1:13-14.

1. What has God done for you through His Son Jesus?

Philippians 2:6-8.

- 2. What did Jesus give up to rescue you from the penalty of sin?
- 3. What did Jesus do to forgive and free you?
- 4. If Jesus did that for you, how do you think He feels about you?
- 5. How do you feel knowing what Jesus did for you?

Read 1 Timothy 2:5-6.

- 6. For what people and what purpose did Jesus sacrifice His life?
- 7. What does that say about the value of all people, including you?
- 8. What's a hindrance to believing you're valuable enough for the Son of God to do all He did for you?

- 9. What step can you take to grow your understanding of how much Jesus values you and others?
- 10. What's one way your life would be different if you had a better understanding of how much Jesus values you? How much He values others?

Spiritual Practice

Spiritual Practices help us experience the Holy Spirit's work in our lives. They're meant to be more than one-time actions, becoming a natural part of our lives.

Read a passage from the *Daily Reading* each day. As you reflect on the Bible verses, ask God, *What are You saying about who I am*? Then complete this sentence with what God says about you: *God says I am...*
