#### **Conversation Starter**

What does it mean to be authentic?

### Begin your study with prayer

Pause for a few minutes to quiet your heart and mind. Then ask God for insight and direction as you study and reflect on this week's lesson.

# **Bible Study and Group Discussion**

#### Read Genesis 39:21-23.

- 1. Joseph was wrongly accused of attempted rape and thrown into prison. How does this challenge your view of God's faithfulness?
- 2. In what ways have you experienced God's help during times of hardship?

#### Read Genesis 40:1-19.

- 3. Who joined Joseph in prison? What positions did they have in Pharoah's court, and why is this important to the story?
- 4. Even though Joseph was in prison, he noticed and cared for the people around him. How can you remain aware of the needs of others when you're going through a difficult situation? What does it take for a person to care deeply about others?
- 5. Joseph gave a positive interpretation of the cupbearer's dream. How do you think Joseph felt giving a negative interpretation to the baker? Think of a time you needed to have a hard conversation with someone. Did you step in with truth, or shrink away? Explain.

#### Read <u>Genesis 40:20-23</u>.

- 6. God's interpretation of the dreams as relayed by Joseph proved true, demonstrating God's continued work in and through his life. How is God working in your life?
- 7. What was Joseph's view of God during his time in prison? How did this impact his actions?
- 8. What practical ways can you show God's love so others see their need for Him?
- 9. Even though the Pharaoh's chief cupbearer *forgot all about Joseph, never giving him another thought* (vs. 23), God had not forgotten him. How does this encourage your faith? What are ways you can remember God's faithfulness during times of trial?

## **Spiritual Practice**

A spiritual practice is training for the soul. By building these into your everyday life, you're sure to strengthen your relationship with God.

Make a list of ways to express genuine faith. Live faithfully before God in at least two of those ways this week.
