Read John 8:31-47 and Romans 6:14-23 and answer the following questions for **each** passage.

- 1. Which verse is most significant to you?
- 2. What are indicators that someone is a slave of sin?
- 3. What are indicators that someone is a child of God?
- 4. How can we be freed from slavery to sin and become a child of God?
- 5. What's attractive to you about being freed from sin and being a child of God?
- 6. What step can you take to live in freedom from sin as a child of God?

Spiritual Practice

Spiritual Practices help us experience the Holy Spirit's work in our lives. They're meant to be more than one-time actions, becoming a natural part of our lives.

Read **Galatians 5:1**, and ask God to show you areas of your life where you may be displaying slavery to something other than Jesus. Confess that to God and experience the freedom of being forgiven through Christ Jesus.
