Family Talk – God's Letter to the Lukewarm

READ TOGETHER

Revelation 3:14-22

- 1. What's undesirable about being lukewarm (vs.15)?
- 2. What's the danger in believing that we have everything we need apart from Jesus (vs. 17)?
- 3. Jesus says that He corrects and disciplines everyone He loves (vs. 19). What has that looked like in your life?

LIVE IT

In each of his messages to the churches, Jesus closes by saying:

"Anyone with ears to hear must listen to the Spirit and understand what He is saying to the churches."

In this final letter, He also speaks of standing at the door and knocking. Those who hear this knock and open the door to Him are called His friends (vs. 20). God calls us to take a stand for Jesus, unlike the Laodiceans, who were lukewarm (or neutral) toward Him. What does it look like when you listen to the Spirit's leading? How would your life be different if you valued friendship with Jesus above all else?

LEAN ON GOD

Dear God,

We want to follow where You lead, but we're often indifferent to Your leading. Give us the courage to stand for You. Give us a keen awareness to hear what You're saying to us. Help us remember that our relationship with You is the most important one we can ever have.
