Family Talk–Turning Away

READ TOGETHER

Galatians 1:6–10

- 1. Why do people sometimes turn away from God?
- 2. What beliefs or ways pretend to be the Good News?
- 3. How is pleasing people different from pleasing Christ?

LIVE IT

In Paul's letter to the Galatians, he reminds them that the Good News he and his friends preached to them is the **only** Good News. Sometimes we can believe that feeling good, having money or being popular will bring us satisfaction. Ultimately, true satisfaction can only be found in the Good News of Jesus – in His sinless life, death, burial and resurrection.

As a family, memorize Colossians 2:8:

Don't let anyone capture you with empty philosophies and high-sounding nonsense that come from human thinking and from the spiritual powers of this world, rather than from Christ.
