Matthew 2:10, Luke 1:46, 2:10

- 1. How would you define joy? How is it different from happiness?
- 2. Why should Jesus' birth bring us joy?
- 3. We sing joy to the world, but how do we share joy with the world?

LIVE IT

The Christmas story is full of joy. The thought of Jesus, Savior of the world, fills Mary, Elizabeth, Elizabeth's unborn child, the shepherds and everyone else with tremendous joy.
