Family Talk– Confrontation

READ TOGETHER

Daniel 5 and Proverbs 12:17 (NLT)

After King Belshazzar dishonored God, Daniel honored God by explaining that the writing on the wall was about the king. Daniel confronted the king's pride while honoring God at the same time.

When your family is together, take turns answering these questions:

- 1. Why do I avoid confronting people with God's truth?
- 2. What is God asking me to confront?
- 3. Do I first pray and ask God for details and His favor before confronting someone?
- 4. Will I be willing to hear and receive feedback when someone else addresses God's truth about my actions?
- 5. Which am I more concerned about, losing someone or gaining Him?

LIVE IT

How many times has God given us a chance to speak truth into the lives of our family, friends or strangers? As we think about truth, focus on God's truth. Avoid focusing on what we want, but instead focus on what God wants.

LEAN ON GOD

God help me to be in tune with You so much that when You send me to confront someone, I'm ready and willing to act regardless of the cost.
