#### **Opening in Prayer**

Show me Your ways, LORD, teach me Your paths. Guide me in Your truth and teach me, for You are God my Savior, and my hope is in You all day long.

Spend a few moments in prayer asking God to guide your time in His Word.

## Personal Reflection/Group Discussion

#### Read <u>Daniel 11:36-12:13</u>.

If you're in a group, consider having group members take turns reading through this passage out loud.

- 1. The overarching message of Daniel is that God will ultimately triumph over evil, evil angels, evil rulers and all human kingdoms of the earth. What did that truth produce in Daniel? What do you want this truth to produce in you?
- 2. In what ways is your life a spiritual battle? See also: Romans 8:12-13; 1 John 2:11-17; Ephesians 6:10-18.
- 3. In today's world, what groups of people would find Daniel's book most encouraging? Who might find Daniel's book terrifying?
- 4. After studying Daniel these past several weeks, what aspect of the character and nature of God stands out to you, and how has this changed or strengthened your relationship with God?

- 5. Honestly evaluate your own values, priorities and character. What strengths do you share with Daniel? What weaknesses are exposed when you compare yourself with him?
- 6. As you wait for Jesus to return, what does God want you to be doing? How does He want you to feel? What does He want you to know? Study these passages to guide your thinking:
  - a. <u>Revelation 3:10-11</u>
  - b. 2 Thessalonians 2:1-12
  - c. <u>1 John 2:18; 5:20-21</u>
  - d. <u>2 Peter 3:2-14</u>
  - e. <u>1 Thessalonians 5:1-11</u>

#### **Soul Training**

Read Romans 15:13. Thank God for making joy and peace available to us through the death and resurrection of Jesus. Ask God to fill you with hope.
